Advanced Placement classes at St. Mary's Parish High School are accelerated, college level courses that are offered to approved High School students. These classes are typically open to students in Grades 11 and 12, but exceptions can be made for underclassmen on a case by case basis. Students that take these classes should be ready to take on the demands of a challenging course, have met the criteria for admittance, understand the expectations and the cost involved, and have approval from the teacher, parent and administration.

- AP Students must:
 - 1) Have a good attendance record. The amount of material covered each day will require daily participation.
 - 2) Have successfully completed any pre-requisites.
 - 3) Complete the AP summer reading and all assignments by the beginning of the 2020/2021 school year. ****Failure to complete 100% of the assignments by the first day of school will result in the student being removed from the Advanced Placement class.**
 - 4) Turn in the commitment form signed by the student, parents, teacher, and administration.
 - 5) Commit to taking the Advanced Placement Exam in May of 2021 for a fee of \$94.00 per exam. (**This fee must be paid through the FACTS billing system by November 2020)
